The program uses a person-centered approach to develop, enhance, or maintain skills that allow each individual to thrive in their community.

Program Experience

- Career exploration through volunteer experiences, internships, and/or situational assessments.
- Community integration experiences to support fuller participation in community life.
- Skill development and training.
- Development of Activities of Daily Living and Independent Living Skills.
- Socialization experiences and support to enhance interpersonal skills.
- Pursuit of personal interests and hobbies.
- Community Outings.
